DOCK, Women's Ministries of the church, continue their Bible Study on King David, "A Heart Like

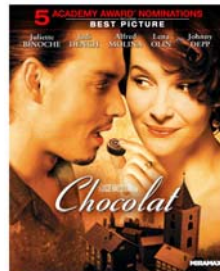
His." Participants meet Wednesdays at 10:00 in Fellowship Hall.
