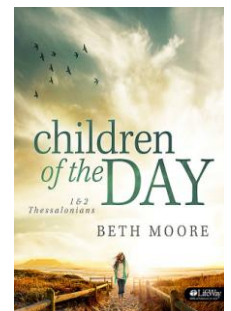
## DOCK NEWS! Women's Ministries of The Church at Lake Cherokee
