Dinner will be served and babysitting will be provided during the Mini Market; so bring some friends to get new clothing FREE and get some early Christmas shopping done!

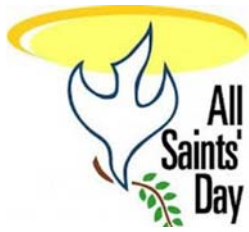

Two Important Observances

As a worshipping community, each fall there are two important “occasions” to remember, reflect and give thanks.



All Saints Day is Sunday, November 1 when, with reverence and memory, we speak the names of loved ones who have died, especially honoring those who have died since All Saints Day, 2014. The day has been observed since the 9th Century at various times of the year by Roman Catholic, Anglican / Episcopal and Protestant Christians. All Saints Day –sometimes called “All Souls Day”— is the original and religious dimension of an annual observance which morphed into All Hallows Eve or Halloween.



Veterans Day Sunday, November 8, the Sunday prior to Veterans Day, we remember with gratitude all of whom we know who have served in the U.S. military. Veterans Day was first observed as **Armistice Day** commemorating the end of World War I, the “war to end all wars.” However, the observance was changed to **Veterans Day** honoring men and women who have served in all branches of the U.S. military.
