Lent & Easter at The Church at Lake Cherokee

Lent, beginning with Ash Wednesday, is a time to prepare for Easter: February 13 – March 30. Lent is generally a “season” of prayer, reflection, focus and renewal. The word “lent” is derived from an Old English word for “lengthen,” referring to the longer days of spring. Lent is a “spiritual springtime.”

- **Ash Wednesday Pancake Supper and Worship** with Imposition of Ashes, February 13th, 6:45 pm
- **Palm Sunday** and the Celebration of Jesus’ Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem, March 24th
- **Maundy Thursday**, commemorating Jesus’ initiating the Last Supper and the Betrayal and Denial which followed, March 28th, 7:00pm: “A Service of Communion and Shadows!”
- **EASTER** and the Celebration of Jesus’ Resurrection, Sunday, March 31st
