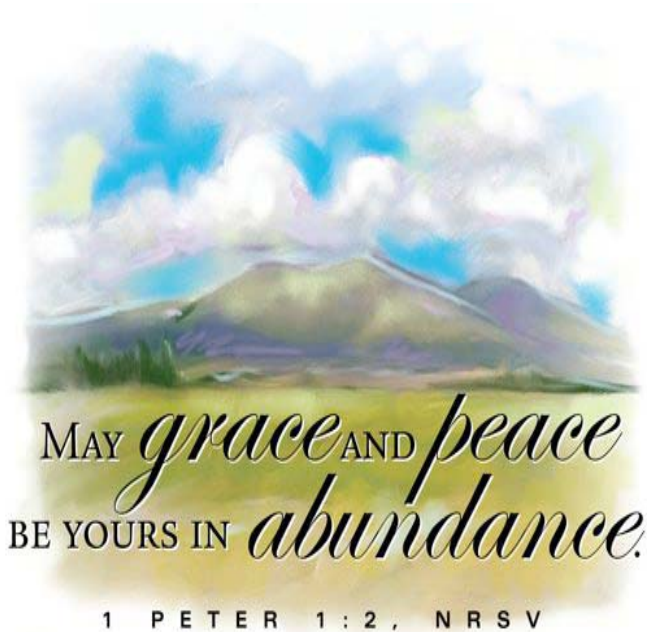
- The July Monthly Youth Event is July 21st at the Smythes, 5:00 PM, to go to Firecracker Island

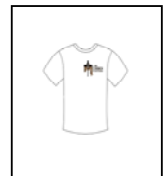


## THE CHURCH AT LAKE CHEROKEE T- SHIRTS
