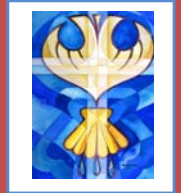

Out Reach Ministries

This week, church members received an emailed "thank you note" from a parent whose children benefited from the Back Pack Ministry! *It's working!* The project is organized by Women's Ministries with the youth packing the "back packs" each Sunday evening. This food donation goes, discretely, to children in Tatum Independent School District who are on the school lunch program.

Additionally, members of our church routinely serve meals at Hiway 80 Rescue Mission, support local families in times of crises, support youth and children in summer camping, have hosted a day-camp sponsored by hospice for children who have loved ones die and provide food to Hiway 80 Rescue Mission and the Samaritan House in Tatum.

Currently, the Samaritan House is assisting approximately 150 families each month with supplemental foods. Unfortunately, we are not collecting enough food in the "Yellow Wagon" in Fellowship Hall. WILL YOU HELP? Food items especially needed are foods high in protein including canned meats, meatballs and spaghetti, soups with meat; and as always, peanut butter! Sunday as you start out the door with a covered dish, include something for someone else!
