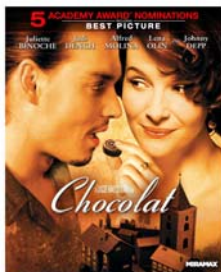

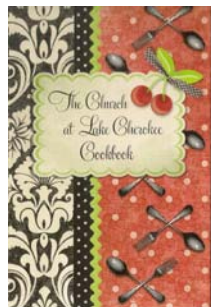
## Cookbooks For Sale

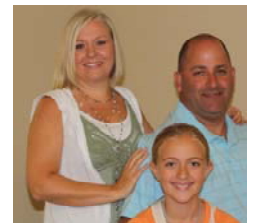
Under his participation and the leadership of Sharon Graves and Bill Smythe, the youth ministry has grown in participants and program.
