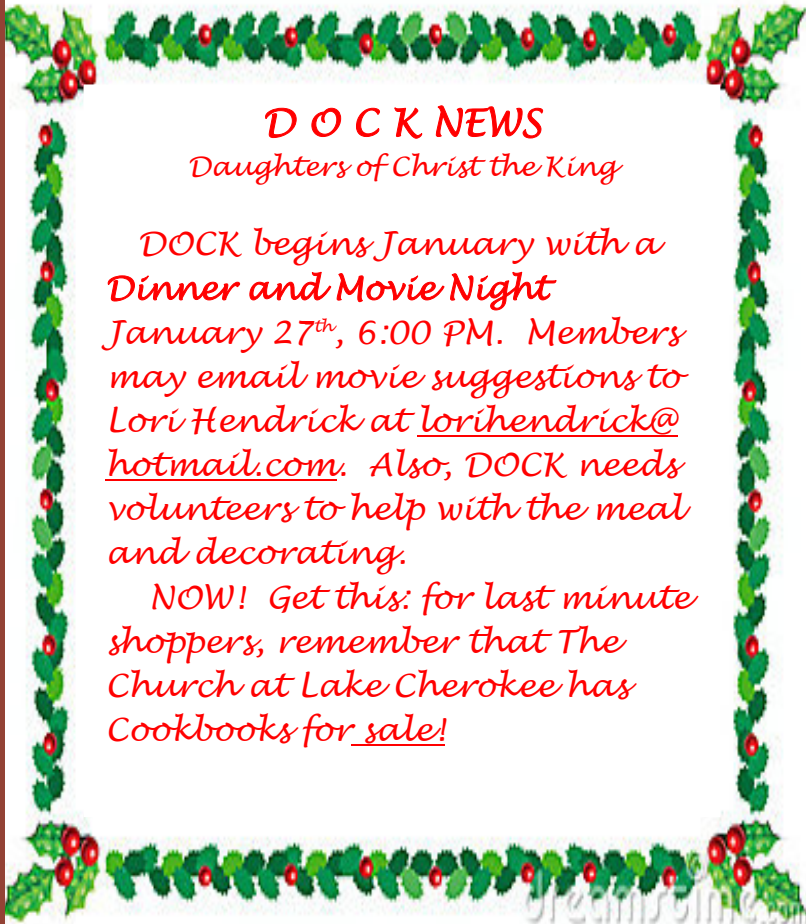

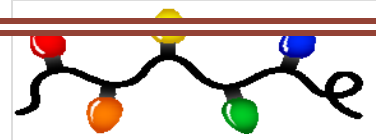
Here's Some Mission News
