Currently the Samaritan House in Tatum needs PEANUT BUTTER for distribution to folks



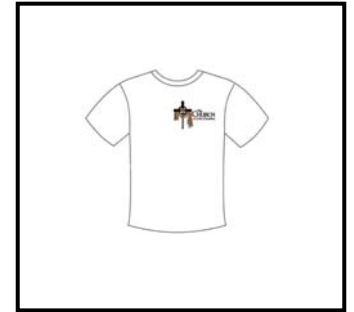
